The Oblong Children's Christian Home is a ministry of Christian Churches and Churches of Christ to abused and troubled children who are 5 to 17 years of age, providing them:

- · unconditional love,
- · a stable, structured environment, and
- · family-style group homes.

Children come to our Home for a variety of reasons. It may be because

- · the child is running with the wrong crowd,
- · the child is not attending school,
- · the child has a difficult home situation, or
- the child has mild to moderate legal problems.

For most families, the goal is for the child to return home after making significant changes. The length of stay is determined by how long it takes the child and his/her family to achieve the goals set at placement. To overcome the destructive habits that lead to placement and to replace them with healthy habits that are maintained when the child returns home normally takes at least 18 months. The need for continued care is reviewed after 12 months and every 6 months thereafter.

Children are not turned away from our Home because of their race, faith, creed, or family financial condition.

9th Annual Race for the Kids • May 7, 2016 • Hutsonville, IL (Hutsonville City Park) • 8:00 AM

9th Annual Race for the Kids
duathlon and 5K right here!

The gun will sound at 8:00 a.m. (CDT) on May 7, 2016 for the 9th Annual Race for the Kids, a joint duathlon and 5K for the benefit of the Oblong Children's Christian Home. The start/finish line will be the same for both races: the northern-most entrance to the Hutsonville City Park in Hutsonville, IL. Participants may choose to compete in the 5K or in the duathlon (2-mile run, 20-mile bike ride, and concluding 2-mile run). Registration/packet pick-up begins at 6:45 a.m. and continues until 7:45 a.m.

Cost: Early bird registration (postmarked by April 20) is \$25 per individual or \$50 per team. Teams consist of two members—one biker and one runner. Entry forms must be submitted together. (Please specify biker or runner.) Late registration fees (postmarked after April 20) and on-site registrations are \$30 per individual or \$60 per team.

ENTRY FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.

Awards: Awards will be presented immediately following each race (5K and duathlon) in the following age categories: 20 and under, 21—30, 31—40, 41—50, 51—60, and 61 and over. Also receiving

recognition will be the overall 5K winners (male and female), the overall individual duathlon winners (male and female), and the overall duathlon team winners.

Participants will receive: A commemorative tshirt (guaranteed only to those who preregister), a finisher medal, goody bag, and post-race refreshments.

ALL PARTICIPANTS WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR RANDOMLY DRAWN DOOR PRIZES AS WELL.

Course description: The duathlon begins with a flat 2 miles (out and back) followed by 20 miles by bike (gentle, rolling hills), following a lollipop route. Participants conclude with the same, flat, 2-mile out-and-back run. The 5K course begins at the park. Participants will run or walk through town (loop, flat, paved roadway).
